I can look for books, play with toys, or use the computer.








I might need to share the toys with other children. Sometimes, it is loud because other children are playing.

There are other bathrooms too. There is also a water fountain in case I get thirsty.




Sometimes, there is a fun program that I can go to in the Community Room.

There is a fireplace upstairs. If the weather is cold, the fireplace will be on and I can sit in a soft chair in front of it.




In the spring and summer, the library garden is open. I can sit outside and enjoy the weather.
